Administrators' Code of Conduct

1. Ensure that equal opportunities for participation in netball are made available to all children, regardless of ability, size, shape, sex, age, disability or ethnic origin;
2. Ensure that rules, equipment, length of games and training schedules take into consideration the age, ability and maturity level of participating children;
3. Ensure that adequate supervision is provided by qualified and competent coaches and officials capable of developing appropriate sports behaviour and skill technique;
4. Remember that children participate for enjoyment and play down the importance of awards;
5. Ensure that parents, coaches, sponsors and participants understand their responsibilities regarding fair play;
6. Condemn unsporting behaviour and promote respect for all opponents;
7. Ensure that your behaviour is consistent with the principles of good sporting behavior;
8. Make a personal commitment to keep yourself informed of sound officiating principles and the principles of growth and development of children;
9. Ensure promotion, well being and safety of umpires and encourage good sportsmanship before, during and after matches;
10. Ensure positive player / umpire / relationship is continually developed;
11. Resolve conflicts fairly and promptly through established procedures;
12. Maintain strict impartiality;
13. Be aware of your legal responsibilities;
14. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
