



## Return to Play After Concussion

### Concussion Procedures at Fremantle Netball Association

1. The patient must attend First Aid room at FNA for assessment.
2. The patient receives a copy of this form to be completed by a Doctor of Medicine for clearance to return to sport, which must be returned to the FNA office prior to participating in netball training and games.
3. The patient receives a copy of the relevant Concussion in Sport Australia – Return to Sport Protocol (for children 18 years of age or under, or for adults over 18 years of age), based on their age.
