UMPIRE AFFILIATION

Adopted Feb 2016

A) INTENT OF POLICY

The policy is to ensure that Fremantle Netball Association (Inc) [hereafter referred to as FNA] provides guidelines for the requirement for umpires (who are not players) but who are paid for their services for umpiring, or undertaking NOAS Accreditation (National Officiating Accreditation Scheme) in the current year, or who wish to retain their current accreditation for the current year shall be affiliated members of Netball WA, Coastal Netball Region and FNA and pay the Non-Player Full affiliate fee for the current year.

B) POLICY BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE

FNA has a responsibility to ensure all umpires, who are not players but who are paid for their services for umpiring are financial and affiliated members of Netball WA before they officiate at FNA as an on court umpire.

C) HOW THE POLICY WORKS

Clubs or the individual are responsible to provide the required information to be registered on the MyNetball data base system and pay the fee due. Information required is Name; Address; Date of Birth, Mobile Phone number, email address, emergency contact name and emergency contact telephone number.

D) THE POLICY

Clubs who engage an umpire/s (who is not player/s) and pay for their services for umpiring to cover Club umpiring commitments:

1. Have a responsibility to ensure such umpires are affiliated as Non-Player Full Affiliate member/s prior to umpiring at FNA; and
2. Have a responsibility to ensure such umpire/s (if over the age of 18 years) have a current Working with Children check (or be exempt from obtaining a check). For enquires on this visit www.checkwwc.wa.gov.au
