SINGLE GAME VOUCHER POLICY

A) INTENT OF POLICY

To cover an individual who only plays one or two games at Fremantle Netball Association (Inc) [hereafter referred to as FNA] during a season. Instead of paying the full membership fee, the player simply purchases a “single game voucher” for each game.

B) HOW THE POLICY WORKS

The voucher ensures the player is covered by Netball WA insurance in the event of an injury and includes an FNA on cost, towards running the competition.

C) THE POLICY

1. An individual can only play under this system twice, regardless of which club they play for, then they must fully affiliate.
2. Fees paid for single game vouchers cannot be used towards payment for full affiliation.
3. Once an individual has played on a single game voucher/s
 - i. they may affiliate to play in any club;
 - ii. game/s played on single game vouchers do count towards eligibility to participate in final round matches, if such games were played for the team the player is affiliating with.

D) MATCH PROCEDURES

Individual players or Clubs may purchase vouchers, for the day, from the FNA office (details of name, address and date of birth are required to complete the voucher).

1. Cost \$15.
2. The voucher is valid for one day only.
3. The voucher must be purchased and completed prior to the individual taking the court.
4. The voucher number must be recorded against the players’ name on the score card.
5. An individual purchasing or issued (via their Club) their single game voucher must be provided with the receipt section of the voucher.
6. The single game voucher fee is non-refundable and cannot be used as part payment for full membership.
7. A single game voucher player is not eligible for any benefit other than the insurance coverage on that day and participation in the FNA competition on that day.
8. All injuries must be reported to the Association at the time of the injury.
9. Details of the injury i.e. what type, must be entered on the back of voucher stub.
10. A copy of the receipt section of the voucher must be submitted with any injury claim to the insurance company.

E) PENALTY

1. Should a player who is not affiliated with FNA play for a Club without purchasing a single game voucher, the penalty shall be the loss of two (2) match points from team the individual played for.
2. All FNA rules, as detailed above, must be adhered to and the penalty for failure to conform shall be the loss of two (2) match points from team failing to comply.
