TEAM WITHDRAWAL – NON REFUND OF FEES POLICY

A) INTENT OF POLICY

The policy is to ensure that Fremantle Netball Association (Inc) [hereafter referred to as FNA] provides a policy for Clubs to define the procedure FNA will take when teams withdraw from the competition

- (i) after registration and grading have been completed;
- (ii) after the season fixtures have been drawn up;
- (iii) after the season has commenced.

B) HOW THE POLICY WORKS

The policy sets out the penalties that will be applied by FNA in with dealing Club teams who withdraw from the competition. It is the Club's responsibility to ensure registered team/s complete the season.

In extenuating circumstances a Club may apply to the Executive for consideration of an individual case.

C) THE POLICY

A team who withdraws from the competition after registration and grading has been completed Withdrawal fee

1. A \$200 exit fee applies.

A team who withdraws from the competition after the season fixture has been drawn up Withdrawal fees

- 1. A one third total team fee is retained (this fee is payable on Registration Day);
- 2. Plus a \$200 exit fee applies.

A team who withdraws from the competition after the season has commenced Withdrawal fees

- 1. The full total team fee is retained (this fee is payable by week 4 of the season);
- 2. There shall be no refund of fees in this situation.
- 3. Plus a \$200 exit fee applies.

D) PENALTY

In accordance with the Constitution and By-Laws of FNA (Constitution 9.0, 9.1.3[1]) and (By-Law 10.2, 10.2.1 and 10.2.2) a Club will remain liable for the above fees and will not be deemed financial until they are paid.

In the case of a single Club team each player in that team shall be liable for one seventh of the debt (relevant to the time of withdrawal i.e. exit fee and team fee) and will not be eligible to play for another Club or affiliated Association until the debt is paid to FNA.
